- Population: 82 Million
- Balanced gender distribution
- %68: between the ages of 15-64, that is, at working ages
- %23,4 : lower than 15
- %9 : over 65
- Mean age of Turkey is: 32

Demographic Window of Opportunity: A suitable and potential population for economic development...


Turkey: just at this point...

Population issues during previous century: dramatic increase


Population issues during this century:













The number of international students, which was around 48 thousands in 2014, has exceeded 240 thousands in 2021.



What is RPL?

- Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is a process by which both formal learning for recognised awards, informal learning from experience and non-formal learning for uncertificated but planned learning is given academic recognition.
- RPL is a cornerstone of the lifelong learning policies.

Types of Learning


