



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ECIU's Challenge-Based Learning



CHALLENGE-BASED LEARNING (CBL)

A pedagogical approach that actively engages learners in a situation that is **real**, **relevant** and **related** to their environment.

It takes place through the identification, analysis and design of a solution.

The learning experience is typically:

- Multidisciplinary
- Involves different stakeholder perspectives
- Aims to find a collaboratively developed solutions



Learners Take Ownership

- define their own challenges
- take over responsibility for team composition
- acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to solve this challenge

Teacher as a Guide and Facilitator

- promoting team culture
- being challenging
- help students to manage the tasks
- enable students to move towards innovative thinking



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Microcredentials

Micro**credentials** in the EU

A record of the learning outcomes that a learner has acquired following a small volume of learning which have been assessed against transparent and clearly defined criteria.


Micro**modules** @ ECIU

EU + ECIU Characteristics:

- Provided by an accredited institution or program (via ECIU network)
- 1-3 ECTS (or unbundled from a larger module)
- Currently mostly master's level, but bachelor's level being added
- Priority for online provision, offline possible



Broad Range of ECIU Learning Opportunities Leading to Digital Credentials




Digital Credentials for all Learning Opportunities



Several Microcredential platforms available

- Forgery-proof, verifiable, awarded to the learner and stored in learner-owned digital profile
- ECIU University using Certificates of successful participation as an intermediate solution
- Low understanding about available platforms and their features, EDC (Europass) becoming the European standard
